

# Real ID One Pager

## Why do you need a Real ID and by when?

- **By May 2025**, a Real ID will be required to fly domestically and to enter some federal buildings, prisons, and military bases.
- A passport is an acceptable form of identification and may be used instead of a REAL ID Drivers License or ID to board domestic flights and visit federal facilities.

### **If you need help with a birth certificate...**

- Contact the County Health Department where you were born
- Birth certificates can also be acquired directly from the health department in person.

### **If you were born in Indiana...**

- If you were born in Indiana visit [www.in.gov/health/vital-records/](http://www.in.gov/health/vital-records/)
- If you were born in Marion County, contact the Marion County Health Department (317) 221-2400

### **If you were born out of state...**

- If you were born out of state, search the county & state of your birth in a web browser to find the local health department – for example: Allen County, Indiana, birth certificate

### **If you need help with a social security card...**

- For a new card, visit [www.SSA.org](http://www.SSA.org)
- There is a limit to 10 cards per lifetime

### **If you are homeless and need an address...**

- A family member or nonprofit/agency employee with an ID or license of their own can vouch for you. Their ID does not have to be a Real ID. See [form 50879](#) Indiana Residency Affidavit.
- If a person is in long-term stay at a hotel and the hotel is willing to write a letter on hotel letterhead stating the person is staying and can receive mail there.
